

## Wolfgang Hasberg

Prof. Dr. Wolfgang Hasberg has earned his doctorate at the University of Cologne in 1993 and his habilitation (postdoctoral qualification) 2000 at the University Augsburg, 2000-2002 he was professor at University Leipzig and since 2002 he holds a chair for Medieval History and History Didactics at the University of Cologne. His research interests relate to the (1) theory and didactics of history as well as to the (2) history of historical science, (3) medieval history and (4) historiography, and (5) medieval regional history. He has published books and essays on all these topics and has also written textbooks and teaching materials.
